Acquisition on Tract 58

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The Jenny Lind Road & Ingersoll Avenue Widening Project includes the re-construction and widening of Jenny Lind Road from Cavanaugh Road to Zero Street, widening of Ingersoll Avenue from Highway 271 to Jenny Lind Road, and the extension of Ingersoll Avenue from Jenny Lind Road to Highway 71. Right of way acquisition is nearly complete, and the demolition contract to remove the 11 structures previously acquired is underway. The utility relocation work and roadway construction is scheduled to begin later this year.

We obtained approval from the Board of Directors in November 2012 to acquire Tract 58, owned by Westbrook Development, LLC, for the appraised amount of \$18,300.00. An exhibit showing this tract is attached. During discussions with the property owner, it was determined that the proposed acquisition area would require relocation of an electrical light and underground conduit adjacent to their parking which was not accounted for in the appraisal. Westbrook Development has obtained a quote for relocation of the light in the amount of \$3,675.00 and is requesting compensation for this amount. We concur with their request and have added that cost to the appraisal amount for an adjusted total of \$21,975.00.

Attached is a Resolution to accomplish the above recommendation. I recommend the Resolution be adopted by the Board at the next regular meeting.

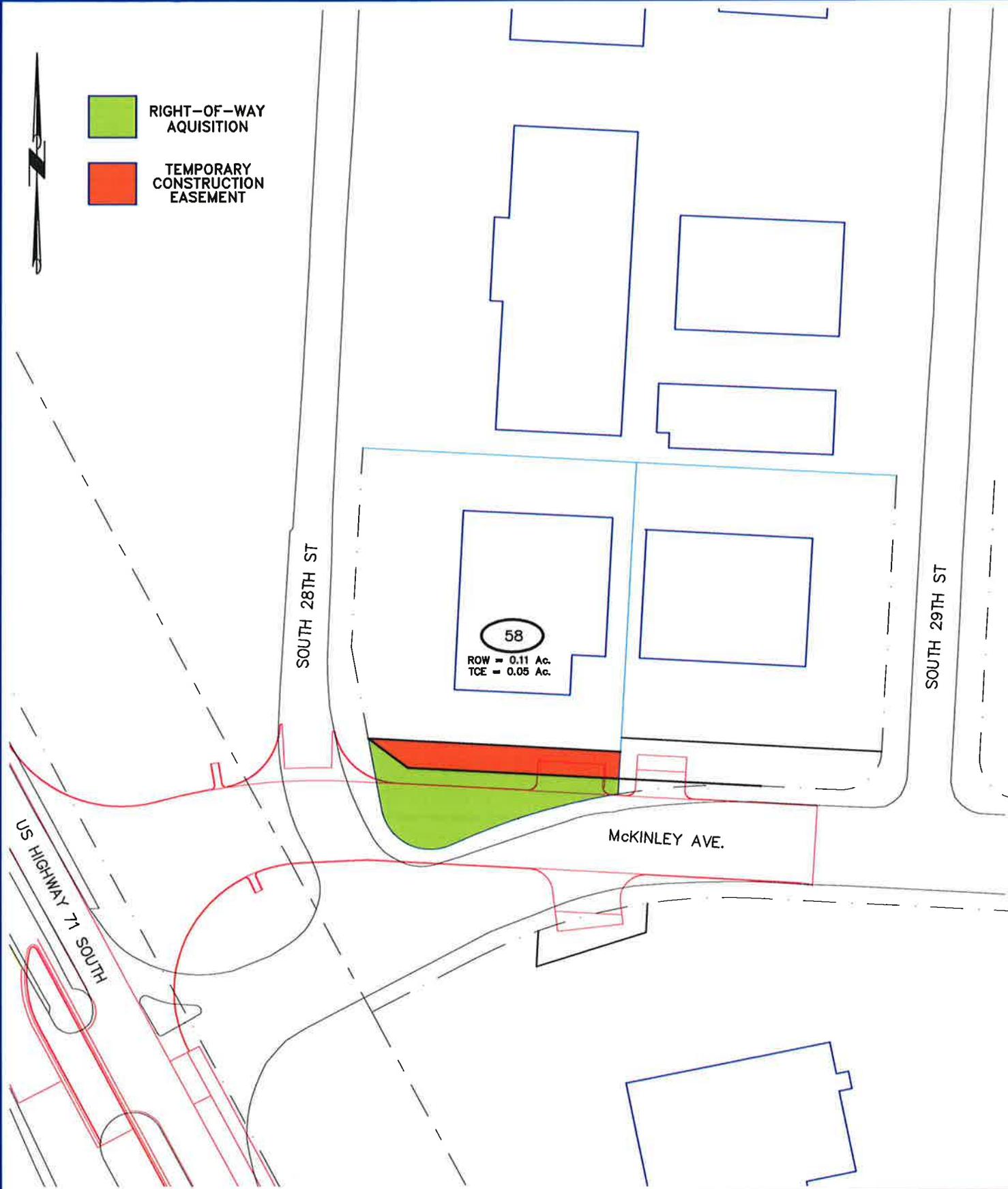

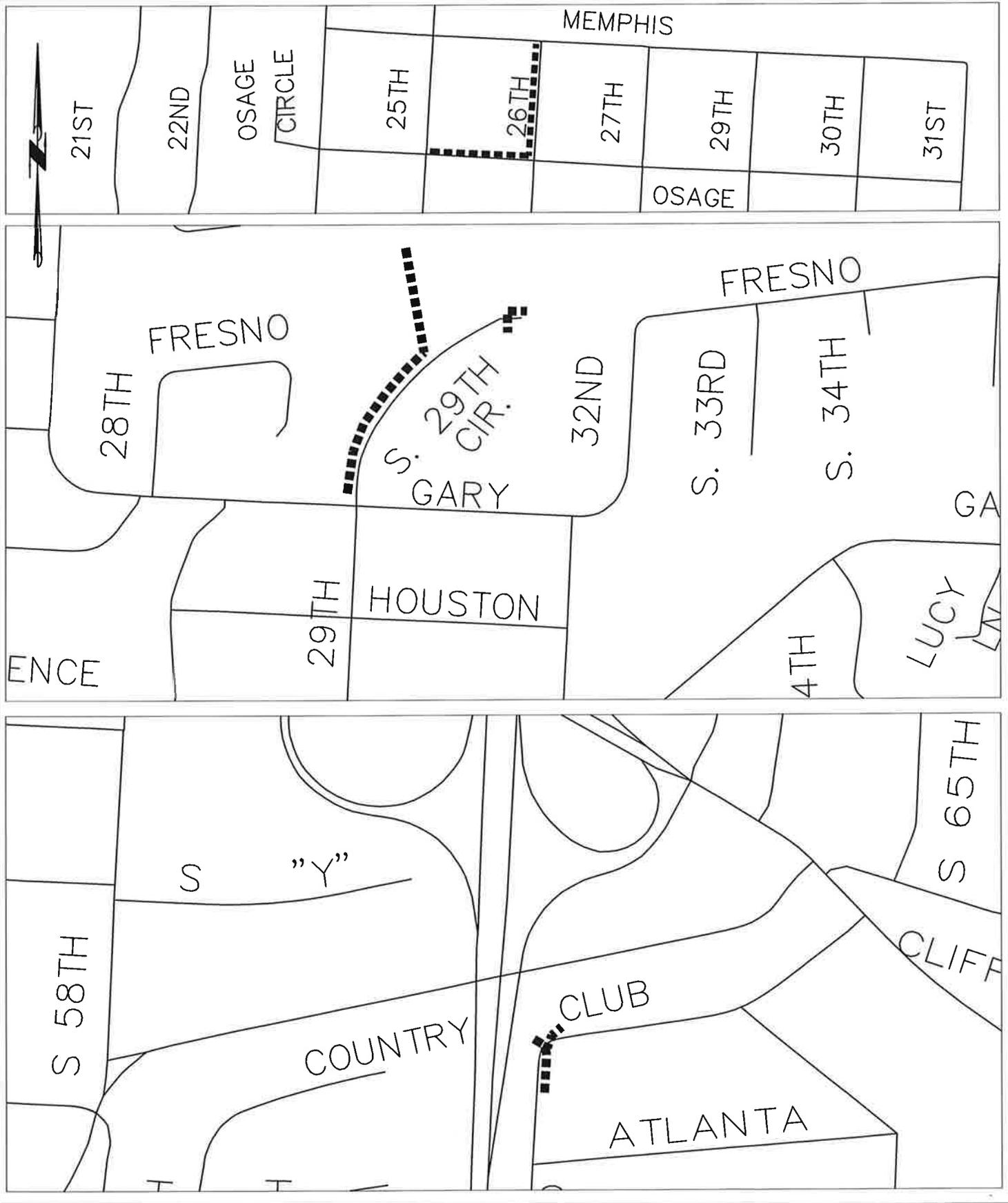

STREET OVERLAYS/RECONSTRUCTION



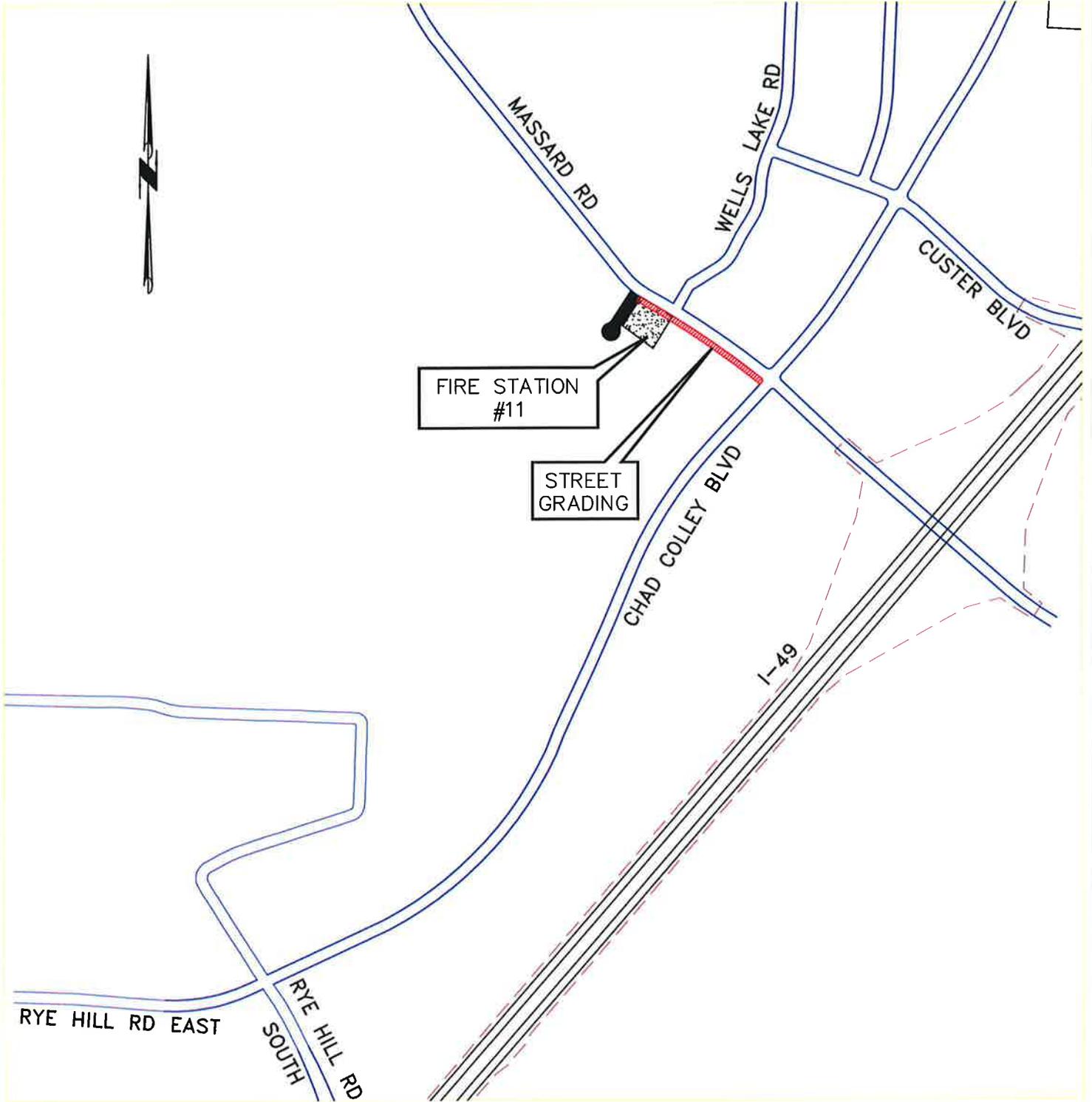

## Lease Agreement

This Lease Agreement executed on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of May, 2014, between the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas, LESSOR, and Webster University, 470 East Lockwood Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63119-3194, LESSEE, witness:

1. The primary term of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year, commencing effective June 1st, 2014, and continuing through May 31st, 2015.

2. The LESSOR hereby leases to the LESSEE, at the rental rate of \$2,070.00 per month, the following property of the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas: a portion of the lower level of the Convention Center Annex, located at 801 Carnall Ave, Fort Smith, AR 72901.

3. The LESSEE shall use said premises solely for offices and classrooms of Webster University – Fort Smith Campus.

4. The LESSOR agrees to provide space for two classrooms and a computer lab. LESSOR shall provide all utilities, excepting telephone and Internet services, and shall include janitorial services in the price of the lease. LESSEE will provide and pay for its own telephone and Internet service. LESSEE shall obtain the prior written approval of the City Administrator for all installations of fixtures and all interior or exterior modifications to the premises. LESSEE shall, at its expense, maintain the center in good and reasonable repair, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

5. The LESSEE hereby releases the City of Fort Smith from all liability which might arise out of its use of the said premises and hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, boards, commissions, employees, and agents, against and from any and all claims (including, but not limited to, any based on the civil rights and anti-discrimination statutes of the United States and the State of Arkansas), demands, causes of action, actions, suits, proceedings, damages (including, but not limited to, damages to City property, and the cost of liabilities (including the City's cost with respect to its employees and of defending any and all such actions and proceedings described herein)) arising out of or pertaining to the providing of services hereunder by the LESSEE.

6. The LESSEE shall not sub-lease said property without the prior express written permission of the City Administrator.

7. It is agreed by the LESSEE that the LESSOR shall have the right, at all reasonable times, to inspect the facilities and programs being provided by the LESSEE under this Agreement. After inspection or investigation, the LESSOR shall have the right to notify the LESSEE, in writing, of any deficiencies in the program and/or facilities provided under this Agreement, and, if such deficiencies are not cured to LESSOR's sole satisfaction within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of such written notice, LESSOR shall have the absolute right to terminate this Agreement immediately.

Furthermore, the LESSOR in its sole discretion shall have the right to cancel this Agreement upon the happening of any of the following:

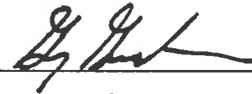
- a. Any substantial damage to or destruction of the leased facilities by fire, wind, or other casualty; or
- b. A determination by the Board of Directors of the City of Fort Smith that the purpose for which the facility was provided by LESSOR is no longer being adhered to; or
- c. A determination by the Board of Directors of the City of Fort Smith that the LESSEE, its employees or agents, in the providing of the services in the leased facilities, have violated the LESSOR's policy against discrimination on the basis of age, sex, religion, national origin, political affiliation, handicap, veteran status, or have violated the LESSOR's policy in favor of a drug-free work place.

Termination or cancellation of this Agreement by the LESSOR prior to the end of the term of the Agreement shall require the approval of the Board of Directors of the City of Fort Smith.

8. The LESSEE may cancel this Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to LESSOR.

Re: Adjustment to Larkin Aquatics contract for the design of the water park

Larkin Aquatics contracted with the City of Fort Smith and Sebastian County to design the water park at Ben Geren Park. Due to owner initiated changes to the scope of services, it is recommended that the contract amount be increased to cover the cost of the additional work. The construction amount has been increased from \$7.5 million to over \$9.3 million.

The addition of a wave pool to the water park is significant both in making the water park a premier facility in our region and in scope of work for the engineer and architect team. Architecturally the addition of water surface added to the size of the main building due to the number of water closets required by code; moreover, the building required to house the pumps and controls that create the wave action for the wave pool was additional work not included in the original scope of work. The engineering team's design of the wave pool was a significant addition that was not anticipated when the contract was approved and required many disciplines and vendors.

The bids received for the water park were favorable and allow for improvements to the plan that will benefit our water park making it the premier facility in our region. The improvements are listed in the letter from Larkin Aquatics which is attached. The improvements include a restroom adjacent to the children's activity pool and play structure making it more convenient for parents to take their children to the restroom and will facilitate future additions to the park. The addition of another pump for the wave pool will allow for the formation of different types of waves improving the citizens' experience and will act as a backup pump in case one of the pumps needs repair. Upgraded signage, more shade, expanded play structure, ultra violet systems on all pool recirculation systems, a sound system, aesthetic improvements, and more landscaping are some of the additional enhancements that require additional engineering and architectural design.

I recommend approval of a fee of \$190,000 of which the City's portion is \$95,000 for the additional services required for these additional features and improvements to the original project. Please contact me if there are any questions or a need for more information.

Subject: Contract Change Order #3 – Landfill Scale Facility Project

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As we near completion of the landfill scale facility, some modifications to the project are necessary to ensure our customer service and facility security standards are met. Much of the equipment used in the weighing process is very technical and requires integration between several systems which involves a great deal of coordination between the architect, the general contractor, subcontractors, and several different vendors. We recently learned that the scale weight display boards and accompanying power/network provisions were omitted from the scale facility plans due to miscommunication among potential equipment providers. The display boards are essential/standard pieces of equipment which provide customers a real-time view of the load weights when they enter and exit the scales.

Bearing in mind the amount of money contained in the building each day and over weekends, the remote location, and poor accessibility by law enforcement after hours, bullet/vandal resistant glass was included in the original building plan to enhance security. However, the plans indicate a clear polished finish which would provide a clear view of cash handling areas and the building layout by the general public. It would also allow increase direct sunlight and heat affecting employee work areas and equipment. A mirrored glass will provide additional insulation from heat and cold which will provide savings on utilities while refracting the bright sunlight during certain parts of the day. The reflective nature of the glass is also necessary in order to shield cash handling areas from public view.

Per the attached Resolution and change order, we are requesting to amend the original contract. The cost associated with the requested changes is \$37,860.53, which brings the adjusted contract amount to \$3,269,502.34. This project is being funded with cash and does not require issuance of debt. Funding for the request is available in the Sanitation Sinking/Landfill Construction Fund.

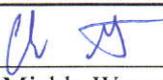

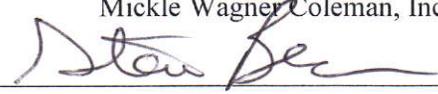

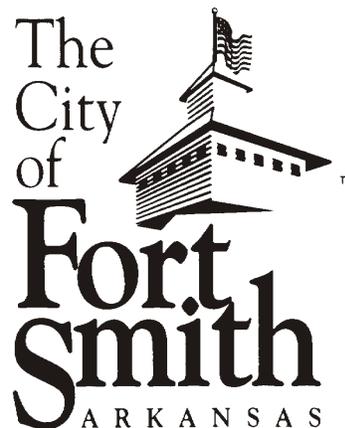

In December of 2005, the Board of Directors approved Ordinance 93-05, thereby authorizing the city to participate in State cooperative purchasing. This process has enabled us to take advantage of other negotiated contracts that the State of Arkansas participates in.

One of these contracts is the *U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance*, a national organization for local government agencies to assist them in making better use of their collective purchasing powers and improving their overall purchasing effectiveness.

As outlined in the attached memorandum from the Fire Department, *The Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC)* is a member of this alliance. Because of their contract, local governments nationwide are permitted to purchase through their Cooperative Purchasing Program. The State of Arkansas has executed an "Interlocal Contract" with H-GAC through the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance. For your information, I have attached a copy of the State of Arkansas Statute which authorizes interlocal cooperative activities.

The 2014 budget reflects a budgeted amount of \$700,000 in the Sinking Fund that has been established for this purchase in Program 4803.

Please be advised that this purchase fulfills all of the purchasing obligations as mandated by both state and local purchasing requirements; I am therefore recommending that the enclosed resolution is approved.

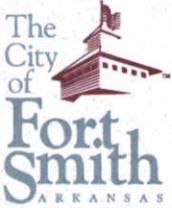

The Fire Department is ready to proceed with the purchase of a 2015 Heavy Duty Rescue Truck to replace an existing 17 year old 1997 International Rescue Truck. We have been able to secure a cooperative purchasing bid through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) program with Pierce Manufacturing and their local fire apparatus dealer, EVS Mid-South in Conway, Arkansas, for the amount of \$738,032.00.

However, the City has the option to take prepay discounts on each fire apparatus. By agreeing to prepay for the fire apparatus at the time of order the City can save \$38,435.00 making the **final purchase price for Heavy Duty Rescue Truck:**

**\$699,597.00**

The funding for this purchase will come from the sinking fund set up with the fire department's share of a ¼ cent reallocated sales tax approved by the citizens of Fort Smith in March, 2012. The purchase price is within the 2014 proposed budget for the rescue truck.

Purchasing the Heavy Duty Rescue from Pierce Manufacturing will help us continue with our program of fleet standardization. Standardizing our fleet of fire apparatus will help keep our long-term operating costs as low as possible by reducing labor hours in repair, having interchangeable parts available thereby reducing inventory costs, and having our mechanic go to fewer training classes than would be required if we were to have multiple manufacturers of fire apparatus.

We have used the H-GAC cooperative purchasing program for fire apparatus for the last several years with great success. Fire Department Staff recommends approval of the resolution accepting the bid for the Heavy Duty Rescue Truck. The delivery of the fire apparatus to the fire department will be approximately 12 months after the purchase order is released to Pierce Manufacturing.

## State of Arkansas Statutes

### Arkansas Code

#### 19-11-206 Definitions concerning intergovernmental relations

As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

(1) "State public procurement unit" means the Office of State Procurement and any other procurement agency of this state;

(2) "Local public procurement unit" means:

(A) Any county, city, town, state agency, and any other subdivision of the state or public agency thereof,

(B) Any fire protection district;

(C) Any regional water distribution district;

(D) Any rural development authority;

(E) Any public authority;

(F) Any public educational, health, or other institution;

(G) Any nonprofit corporation during such time that it contracts with the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services to provide services to the developmentally disabled, provided the contract exceeds seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) per year

(H) Any nonprofit corporation providing fire protection services to a rural area or providing drinking water to the public in a rural area;

(I) Any nonprofit corporation which contracts with the Department of Human Services, provided that the contract includes provisions for transportation services, and the contract exceeds seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) per year; and

(J) To the extent not prohibited by law, any other entity which expends public funds for the acquisition or leasing of commodities and services;

(3) "Public procurement unit" means either a local public procurement unit or a state public procurement unit;

(4)(A) "External procurement activity" means any buying organization not located in this state which, if located in this state, would qualify as a public procurement unit.

(B) An agency of the federal government is an external procurement activity; and

(5) "Cooperative procurement" means procurement conducted by, or on behalf of, more than one (1) public procurement unit or by a public procurement unit with an external procurement activity.

**19-11-249 Cooperative purchasing.**

Any public procurement unit may either participate in, sponsor, conduct, or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the acquisition of any commodities or services with one (1) or more public procurement units or external procurement activities in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants. Such cooperative purchasing may include, but is not limited to, joint or multiparty contracts between public procurement units and open ended state public procurement unit contracts which are made available to local public procurement units.

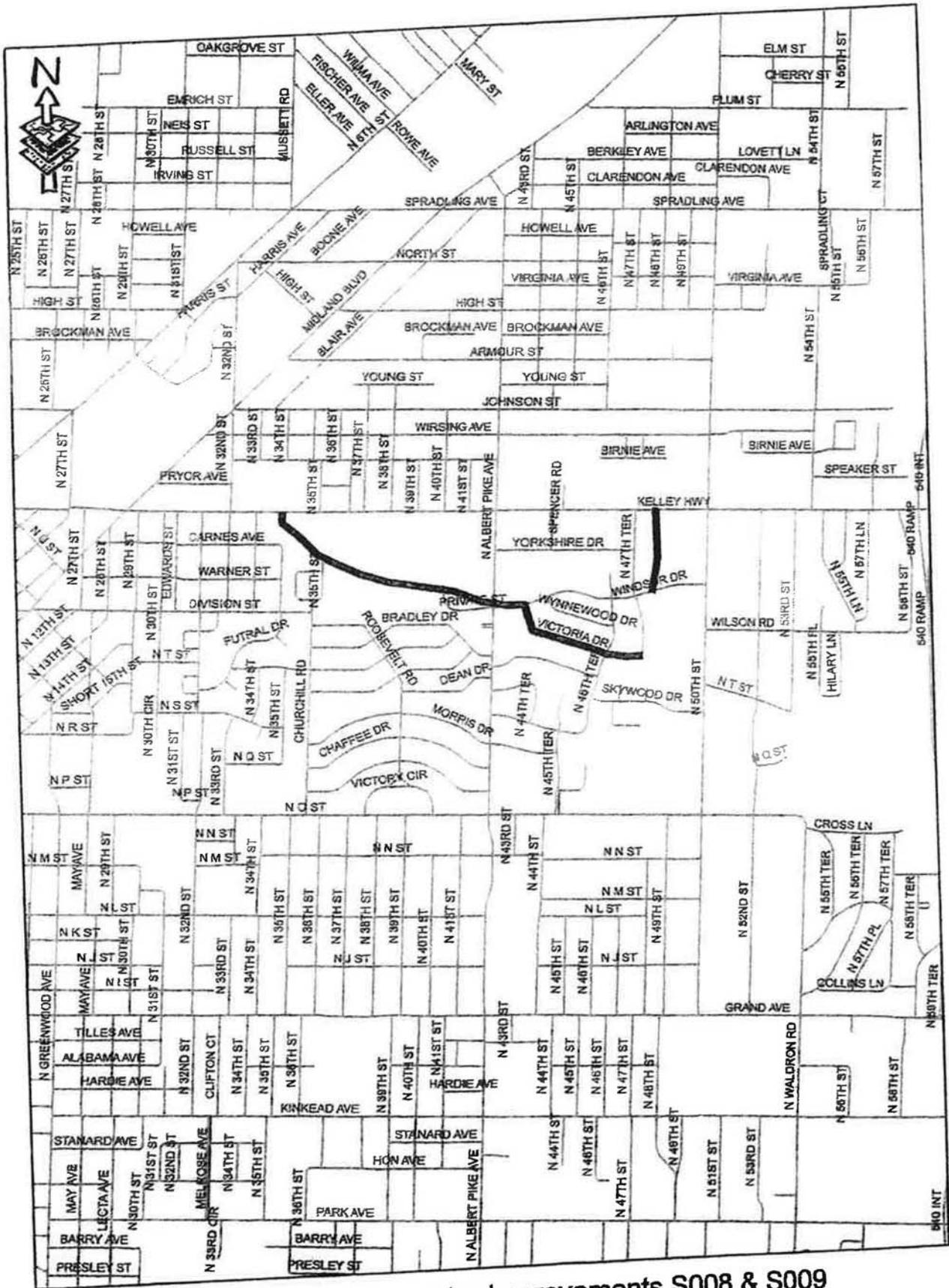

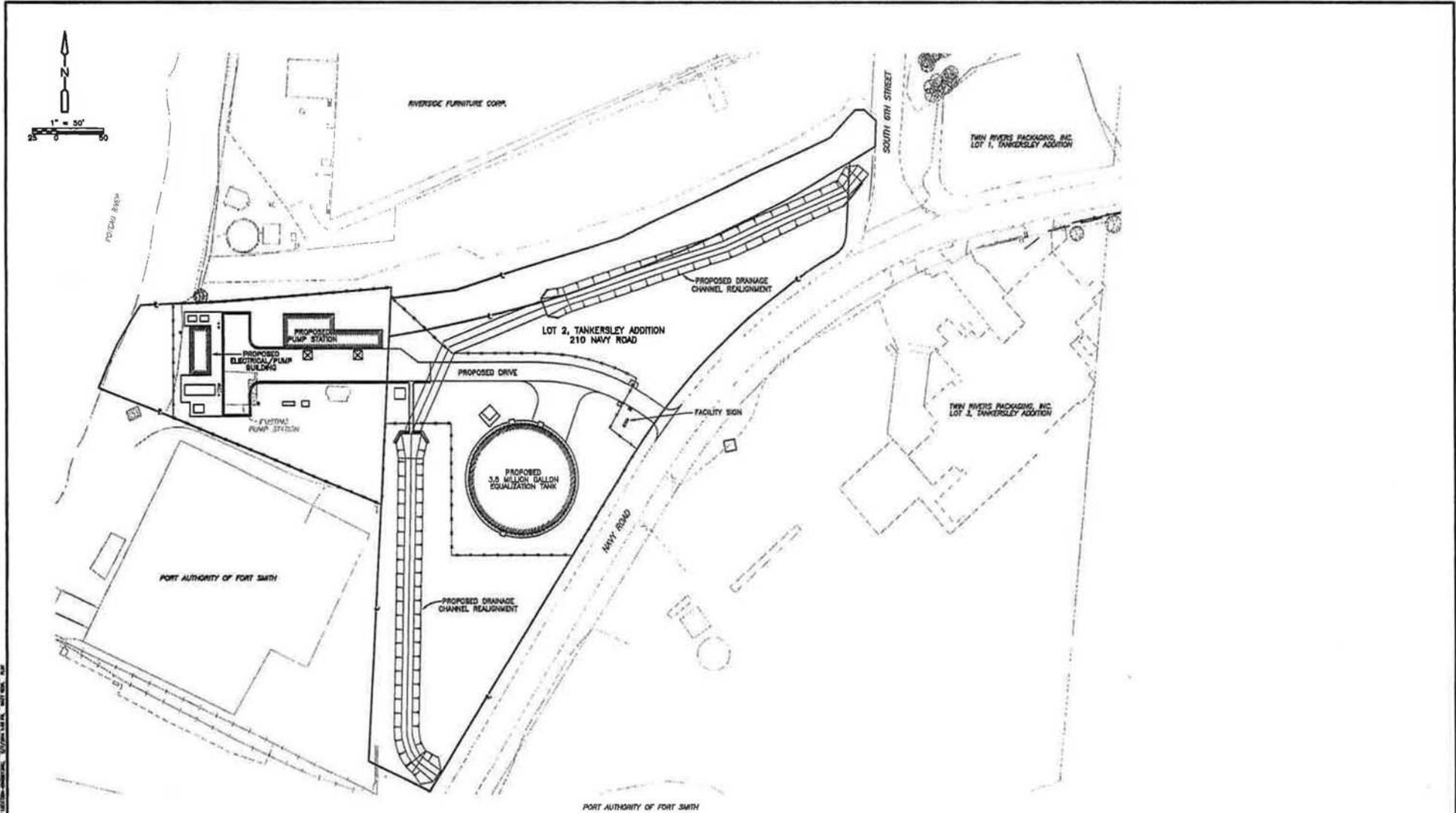

**SUBJECT:** Watershed Protection Acquisitions  
Lake Fort Smith Water Supply

Over the past few months staff has been discussing with Benjamin Raney the need to acquire watershed protection for Lake Fort Smith. All of the property is situated within the watershed boundary area around the lake that the city proposes to acquire for watershed protection, either by a watershed protection easement or by fee title acquisition. The attached two exhibits show the watershed area and general location of the property.

Mr. Raney purchased this 6.21 acre tract of land and single family dwelling at 17901 Boston Mountain Road in 2003. The property is located on the east side of Highway 71 approximately 1 mile from the intersection of Boston Mountain Road. The property drops off sharply toward the shoreline of the lake. Although steep, the property could be subdivided.

The city's appraiser, Matthews and Associates, appraised the land and dwelling for \$125,000.00 and the watershed protection easement for \$25,000.00. This appraisal valuation is similar to previous appraisals of watershed protection easements purchased by the city on Boston Mountain Road. After several discussions, Mr. Raney has offered to sell the city a watershed protection easement for the appraised value of \$25,000.00.

Staff recommends that the attached Resolution accepting the offer extended by Mr. Raney be presented to the Board for their approval at their next scheduled meeting. Should you or members of the Board have any questions or desire additional information, please let me know.

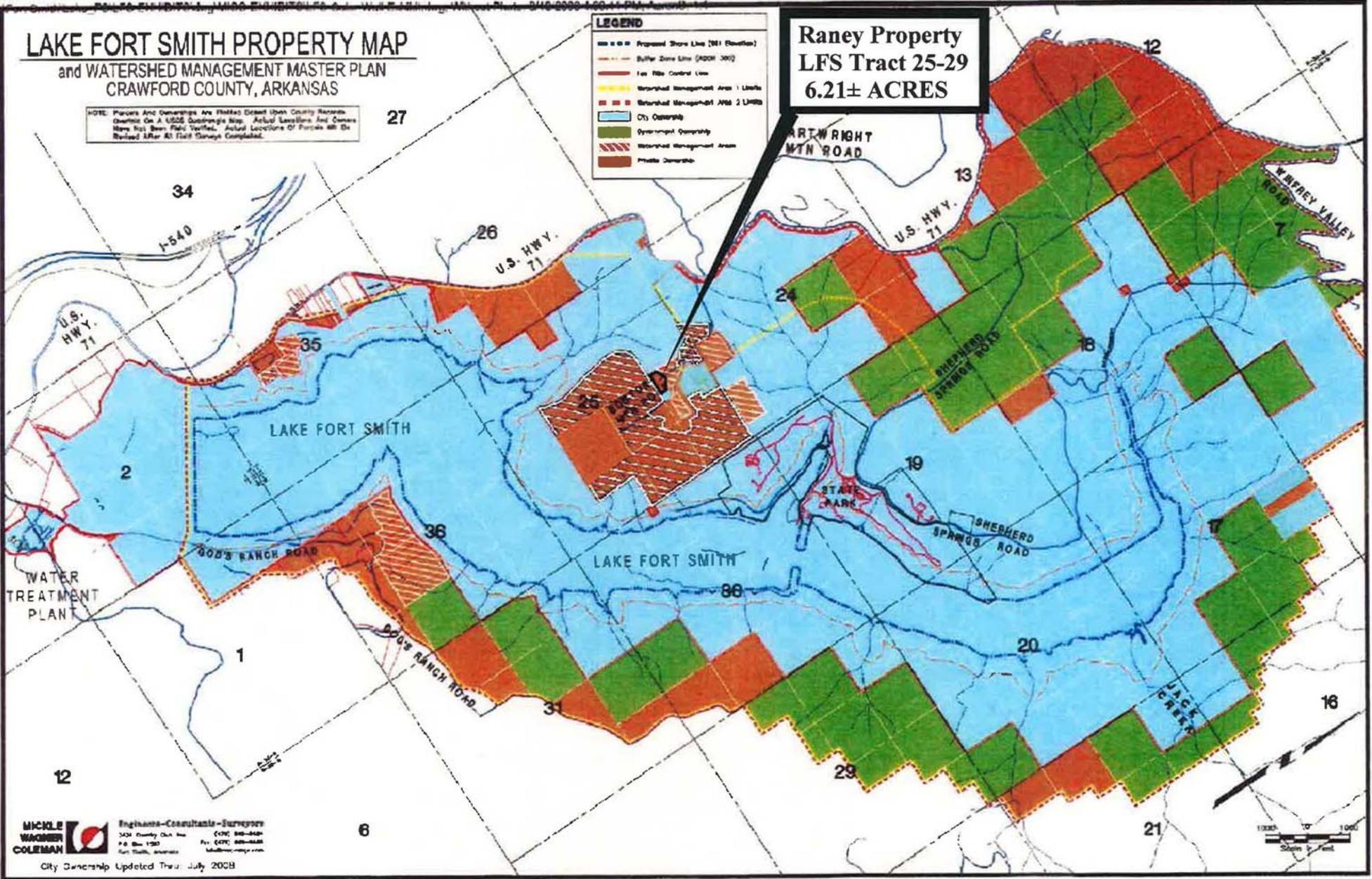

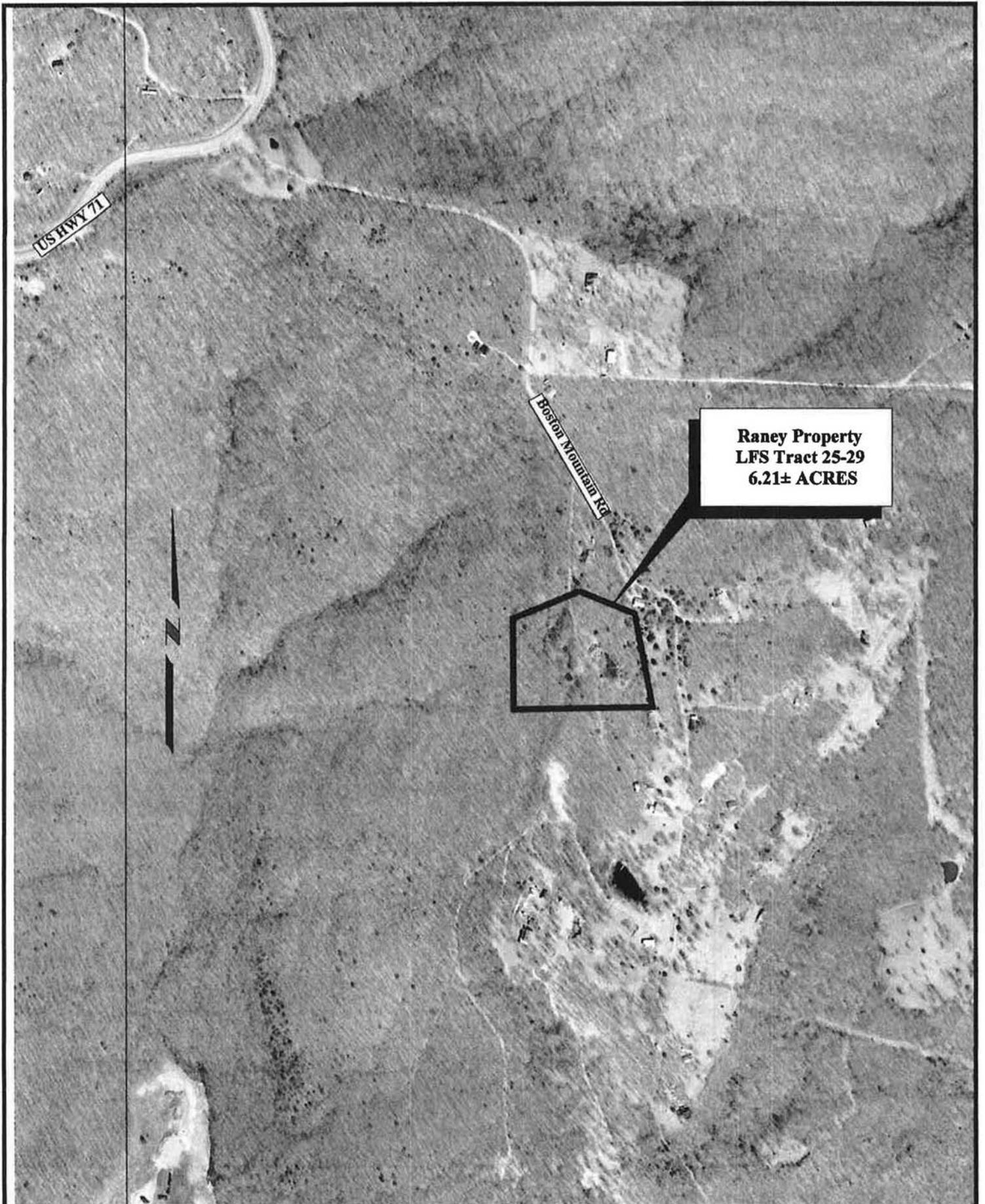
