Subject: Park Hill East Petition Results

During the January 10, 2012 study session, results from the second automated collection customer satisfaction survey for the Park Hill East neighborhood were provided to the Board of Directors. A citizen of the Park Hill East neighborhood indicated that a neighborhood petition was being circulated in an effort to have the service returned to manual collection. The petitions were submitted to the Board at the February 7, 2012 Board of Directors meeting.

The city clerk forwarded a copy of the completed petitions for the Park Hill East, Park Hill North, and Park Hill South neighborhoods to the Department of Sanitation. Department staff evaluated the petition with the goal of providing fairness and transparency. A copy of the original petition submitted to the Board of Directors on February 7, 2012 is attached along with a copy of the spreadsheet we used to present our findings provided below:

Although 156 signatures appear on the Park Hill East petition, some were excluded from our final tally due to different reasons. The addresses that had multiple individuals sign for a single address were only counted once. Some of the addresses physically did not exist. A few were not paying for sanitation services. Some addresses represented were business locations, which do not pay for residential collection services. Additionally, a number of the addresses were not currently receiving automated collection services.

As instructed, department staff conducted two citizen surveys in 2011 (results attached), one for all 3,850 households in the 2011 expansion areas and a second survey of the 278 households in the Park Hill East neighborhood. The results of the first survey concluded that the majority of the respondents (74.5%) who formerly had manual collection wished to continue with automated collection. The Park Hill East survey showed the greatest number of respondents (46.0%) desired to keep the automated service. The results of the petition appear to coincide with the results of the initial surveys conducted by the department.

The automated collection program is currently the most cost effective and efficient method of residential collections in the solid waste management industry. The program has already been expanded to 85.8% of the households in Fort Smith, including those in Park Hill East, and has had a very positive following from the vast majority of households receiving the service.

The petitions submitted included the Park Hill North and Park Hill South neighborhoods. The automated collection program has not been implemented in those areas and information concerning the automated program has not yet been provided to the residents in those neighborhoods. We believe it is premature to make a decision regarding the expansion of the program into those areas until those residents have been educated and their feedback has been solicited.

Some Park Hill East residents have expressed concerns regarding automated collection. These concerns include residents with physical limitations handling the automated cart, no direct access to the street, neighborhood aesthetic, and on-street parking. As a matter of routine, the automated collection program addresses all of these concerns in the Park Hill East neighborhood and other areas receiving automated collections.

The costs associated with manual collections are higher than automated collections when considering the need for additional personnel and equipment along with trying to maintain efficient routes. If the Park Hill East neighborhood is returned to manual collection, the Board may wish to consider enacting a premium service rate to cover the higher cost of providing manual collection services. If we were to return to manual collection, the additional cost per household would be around \$2.50 per month, not to include the additional cost the resident will incur to purchase a replacement trash container. Logical service areas would need to be established to help reduce confusion for residents and collection personnel to include contiguous routing. Service days would change in order to accommodate multiple days of collection.

Based on the results of the city survey and the petitions, it is clear only a minority of households in the entire 2011 expansion area, including the Park Hill East neighborhood, wish to return to manual collection services. Given the desire of the residents, the benefits of automated collection, and our ability to address residents' concerns, we recommend that no changes be made to the 2011 expansion area.




 Phoenix Avenue Overlay District Signage Regulations

Recently the Planning staff and Planning Commission reviewed some issues relating to signage in the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) and the Phoenix Avenue Overlay District. A summary of each issue follows:

Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) Signage Regulations

First, a question was asked about a permit for an outdoor advertising sign (billboard) on a property that is not in the city limits but in the ETJ. After reviewing the regulations, we found that billboards are not allowed in the ETJ. The proposed amendments will allow billboards in the ETJ and establish standards for the installation of billboards similar to the requirements for billboards installed within the city limits.

The next thing we noticed about the ETJ sign regulations is that business signs for can only be allowed with a conditional use. This regulations for a business sign to be approved by a conditional use is unnecessary, burdensome and inconsistent with the sign approval process within the city limits. We propose to amend the ETJ regulations to allow business signs without a conditional use. Also, the ETJ has no regulations regarding the size of signs. Therefore, we are proposing regulations that are consistent with those found inside the city limits for commercial and industrially zoned properties.

Phoenix Avenue Overlay District Design Guidelines - Signage Regulations

The discussion concerning the Phoenix Avenue Signage Regulations evolved during the review of a variance application for the signage at the new Jam Mart/Dunkin Donuts development at South 74th street and Phoenix Avenue. One of the variance requests was about the number of signs permitted on the principal or accessory structure. The current code takes three (3) sections trying to describe what is allowed. These sections are difficult to understand and interpret so we proposed to simplify the code. As you can see from the proposed amendment the proposal is to allow signage to cover 20% of the wall surface for the principal structure and 5% of the wall surface of an accessory structure. The 20% and 5% requirements currently exists in the code. However, the current code limits the number of signs that are allowed. The proposal will not limit the number of signs permitted on the wall surface as long as the total number of signs per wall is equal to or less than the 20% or 5% requirement. For

illustrative purposes, I have included some photographs of large single signs that are permitted by the current regulations and drawings showing the proposed Jam Mart/Dunkin Donut Signs that required variances. The Dollar General and Greg's Too signs are permitted by the current regulations because there is only one sign and the size is less than the 20% limit. The Dunkin Donut signage did not meet the current code because of the number of signs but the size was far below the 20% requirement.

Another variance request this development needed was to allow for an internally illuminated sign. Currently the regulations do not permit internally illuminated monument signs. Wall signs are permitted to be internally illuminated but the monument signs are not allowed to be internally illuminated. The planning staff and planning commission agreed this section should be amended to allow internally illuminated monument signs.

The Planning Commission (PC) voted on these amendments at their February 14, 2012 regular meeting. The PC voted 8 in favor and 0 opposed to recommend the amendments to the Board of Directors.

The City staff recently became aware of some issues concerning the installation of outdoor advertising signs and business signs in the extraterritorial jurisdiction. Also, the recent discussions concerning sign variances for the JAM Mart / Dunkin Donut development at 7401 Phoenix Avenue have raised questions concerning the signage requirements for the Phoenix Avenue Overlay District.

We are presenting some suggested amendments to these sections of the UDO so that we can address the issues and concerns. The proposed amendments are attached:

Below is a brief summary of the proposed amendments:

- A. Section 27-440 (B) – Phoenix Avenue Overlay Signage Regulations – The current regulations have three (3) separate sections that must be reviewed to determine signage and the sections can be difficult to understand. In order to make this section easier to interpret, staff proposes to eliminate limits on the number of signs and replace with a maximum allowed percentage. A maximum of 20% of the wall area for principal structures and 5% for accessory structures are recommended. These percentages currently exist but the number of signs are limited by three (3) separate sections of the code. Internally illuminated signs are allowed except for the monument signs. We propose allowing internally illuminated monument signs.
- B. Section 27-445 – Extraterritorial Jurisdiction Signage Regulations – Currently, the ETJ section contains no regulations for signage including outdoor advertising signs. These amendments provide for regulations that reflect the sign regulations within the city limits for business signs and outdoor advertising signs.

27-445-19 Extraterritorial open zone (ETJ Open-1) created

All real property identified in the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction as defined in section 27-445-2 of these regulations is hereby zoned extraterritorial open zone (ETJ Open-1). The following zoning district regulations shall apply to all properties zoned as ETJ Open-1:

- (1) *Characteristics.* A zone to protect the undeveloped areas within the city's extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction from incompatible land use or other specific uses that may constitute a nuisance to the residents therein or uses that may create an endangerment to the health, safety, or general welfare of the jurisdiction's population. The ETJ Open-1 zone designation may be utilized as a zoning classification for properties until a distinct land utilization pattern is developed in keeping with the city's comprehensive plan and other land use policies.
- (2) *Permitted uses.*
 - a. *General uses:*
 - 1. Single-family homes;
 - 2. Two-family homes (duplexes);
 - 3. Nurseries and greenhouses, private and commercial;
 - 4. Truck farms;
 - 5. Private or public golf courses;
 - 6. Fire and police stations;
 - 7. Utility substations;
 - 8. Parks, playgrounds and other open spaces;
 - b. *Conditional uses:*
 - 1. Agricultural (not including commercial/industrial operations, e.g., commercial food lots, processing plants, sales yards);
 - 2. Churches;

3. Country clubs of more than ten (10) acres;
 4. Boarding schools;
 5. Nursing homes;
 6. Orphanages;
 7. Public, private or parochial schools and colleges (not including industrial trade schools);
 8. Public buildings;
 9. Signs for permitted or conditional uses;
- c. Accessory uses:
1. Guest houses, not including mobile homes and employee's quarters, not including mobile homes.
 2. Accessory farm buildings (requires conditional use permit) including barns, cribs, sheds, tool rooms, shops, bins, tanks, and silos. All structures for the housing of large and small domestic farm animals shall be located no closer than one hundred (100) feet from any property line.
 3. Accessory open or closed storage of farm materials, products, equipment and vehicles.
 4. Accessory farm dwellings, not to include mobile homes, two (2) on farms with a minimum of fifty (50) tillable acres. These dwellings shall share a common entrance from a public or private road or highway and shall be occupied by permanent employees of the farm or immediate members of the family owning or operating the farm. All accessory farm dwellings shall be landscaped and screened from adjacent properties.
 5. Other accessory uses, as determined by the planning commission, that are incidental to the permitted uses and not detrimental to the adjacent properties or the character of the ETJ Open-1 zone.

27-445-20 Rural residential (RR).

- (1) *Purpose.* To provide areas for low intensity agricultural operations and very low density single family uses rural areas. This district is appropriate where low density development is desired or where lack of public facilities and services requires low intensity development. Development in this district shall be designed to allow for the future planned expansion of utilities and services where necessary. RR zoning is appropriate in the low density residential future land use classification of the Fort Smith ETJ land use map.
- (2) *Uses.* Permitted, conditional and accessory uses in the RR district are identified in section 27-445-28, ETJ use matrix. Specific uses not identified on the use list are subject to classification by the director. No more than one (1) principal structure may be erected on each defined lot.
- (3) *Area and bulk regulations.*

27-445- Permitted signs in ETJ Open, ETJ Commercial, and ETJ Industrial

The following types of signs are permitted for all permitted uses, conditional uses and non-residential nonconforming uses in ETJ open, ETJ commercial or ETJ industrial zones.

- (1) All free-standing signs shall not exceed one (1) square foot in area per linear foot of frontage with a maximum area not to exceed three hundred (300) square feet.
- (2) All single face, facade (wall) signs are unlimited in size if placed directly on and are contained totally within the dimensions of the outside wall.
- (3) Outdoor advertising signs shall comply with section 27-445-.

27-445- Outdoor advertising signs

- (a) Outdoor advertising signs are to be considered as a specific use, rather than as an incidental use to an existing land use, in that outdoor advertising signs produce a revenue to the property owner as a land use while the advertising message carried by business signs does not produce a revenue but is incidental to a revenue-producing land use. Because of the special characteristics of outdoor advertising signs as compared with other types of land uses and structures, certain qualifications and requirements are set forth below in connection with outdoor advertising signs as a permitted use.
- (b) Outdoor advertising signs are permitted in ETJ industrial zones and conditional uses in all ETJ open, ETJ commercial.
- (c) No outdoor advertising sign structure of any size shall be permitted to be erected closer than one thousand (1,000) feet from an existing outdoor advertising sign structure which is larger than thirty-five (35) square feet in sign area. No more than four (4) outdoor advertising sign structures (over thirty-five (35) square feet in area) per statute mile are permitted. All measurements shall be made along a line parallel to the street and from the center of the closest support pole.
- (d) No outdoor advertising sign shall be permitted to be erected to exceed a sign area of three hundred (300) square feet, except that with special permission of the city planning commission this limit may be extended to six hundred (600) square feet.
- (e) Within six hundred sixty (660) feet of the right-of-way of an interstate highway, no outdoor advertising sign structure designed to be primarily viewed from the roadway of such interstate highway shall be permitted to be erected closer than five hundred (500) feet to any other such sign structure on the same side of the right-of-way, as measured along a line parallel to such highway, except back-to-back signs.

(f) V-type outdoor advertising signs are not permitted.

27-445- General ETJ sign regulations

(a) Signs shall not be erected or illuminated in such a manner as to obscure or otherwise interfere with an official traffic sign, signal or device, or to obstruct or otherwise interfere with the driver's view of approaching, merging or intersecting traffic.

(b) Signs shall not be erected which imitate or resemble any traffic sign, signal or device, or which are erected or maintained upon trees or painted or drawn upon rocks or natural features, or which are structurally unsafe or in disrepair.

(c) All signs occurring in the sight triangle.:

(1) The sight triangle is described as the area delineated by a distance of twenty-five (25) feet along the intersecting property lines, beginning at the property corner point and extending said twenty-five (25) feet in both directions away from the corner point of intersection and then connecting the terminus points by a line to form the triangular area. A clearance of at least twelve (12) feet to the bottom of the sign shall be maintained, except for not more than two (2) supportive posts which are not more than sixteen (16) inches in width or diameter. Such height of twelve (12) feet is to be measured from the elevation of the center of the lower street.

(d) No flashing signs shall occur in or over any building setbacks or public rights-of-way.

(e) No sign base or support shall be erected in a public right-of-way.

(f) It shall be a violation of this division for any person to place or cause to be placed any sign on any property within the city without first obtaining a certificate of land use from the planning and zoning department.

(g) If a lot has frontage on more than one (1) street, each frontage will have its own permitted sign area. The frontages on two (2) streets may not be combined to determine the permitted sign area for one (1) frontage.

Section 27-440 – Phoenix Avenue Overlay

B. Signage regulations.

1. Monument sign defined. When used herein, "monument sign" shall refer to a ground mounted sign having no more than two (2) faces and being constructed of materials of the same type and in design similar to the principal structure located on the lot on which the sign is located.
2. Signage per lot. Each separately owned lot is allowed no more than one (1) monument sign; provided, any such lot having frontage on two (2) public streets, is allowed no more than two monument signs. In addition to the allowed monument sign(s), each such lot is allowed signs of a maximum total of six (6) square feet to provide traffic directions. No monument sign shall be installed closer than ten (10) feet to the property line of the lot.
3. Sign size. Each monument sign shall be a maximum of six (6) feet high (inclusive of the base and the display area) and shall not be more than one (1) square foot in area per linear foot of lot frontage with a maximum area of seventy-five (75) square feet in area per sign. As to the monument sign for a retail center or business park, as defined in zoning code section 27-200, the sign area and height may be increased by an additional twenty (20) percent if only identification of the name and/or logo of the retail center or business park (and not individual tenants) is used on the monument sign.
4. Wall sign allowance. ~~Each separately owned lot is allowed no more than one (1) wall sign for each separate structure on the lot.~~ The wall sign area for the principal structure shall not exceed twenty (20) percent of the wall area on which the sign is located. The wall sign area for each accessory structure shall not exceed five (5) percent of the wall area on which the sign is located. ~~On any lot having frontage on two (2) public streets, each separate structure is allowed no more than two (2) wall signs.~~
5. ~~A second wall sign is permitted on a principal structure with frontage on one (1) public street and, a third wall sign is permitted on a principal structure having frontage on two (2) public streets, and a fourth wall sign is permitted on a principal structure having frontage on three (3) public streets if the following conditions are met:~~
 - a. ~~The sign is not facing property that is zoned or developed for residential purposes.~~
 - b. ~~The sign is limited to a single logo or business symbol of a business operating in the structures.~~
 - c. ~~The cumulative area of the second or third wall sign allowed with this condition and the wall sign on the first or second walls shall not~~

~~exceed the twenty (20) percent wall area allowed for the first or second wall sign.~~

- ~~6. Additional to the permitted wall sign(s), directional information and building identification signs are permitted on the principal structure if the following conditions are met:
 - ~~a. Not more than two (2) directional or building identification signs are permitted.~~
 - ~~b. The cumulative area of all wall signs shall not exceed twenty (20) percent of the wall area on which the signs are located.~~
 - ~~c. The cumulative wall sign area of the directional or building identification signs is limited to twenty five (25) percent of the wall sign area of the logo or business symbol sign and no directional or building identification sign shall exceed eighteen (18) square feet.~~~~
7. Illumination. Only ground mounted or spotlight (external only) lighting may be used for illumination of monument signs.
8. Sign content. Content of monument signs shall be such that no more than fifty (50) percent of the monument sign may be used for advertising. The remaining area of a monument sign is limited to the name and/or logo of the business(es) operating in the structure.
9. Content of wall signs for the principal structure shall be limited to the name and/or logo of the business(es) operating in the structure. Directional and information signs meeting the conditions of paragraph (4) above are permitted.
10. Content of wall signs for each accessory structure shall be limited to building identification, directional information and the name and/or logo of the business(es) operating in the structure.
11. Advertising shall not be permitted on the principal or accessory structure, wall sign or traffic direction sign.
12. Outdoor advertising (offsite) signs. Outdoor advertising (offsite) signs are prohibited in that portion of the area described in (a) above located between Leigh Avenue and four hundred (400) feet west of the Massard Road right-of-way.
13. Signs prohibited. Banners, marquees and changeable letter reader boards and portable signs are expressly prohibited. Changeable letters and/or numbers are permitted in the advertising portion of monument signs. Except as allowed by this section, no signs shall be installed in the area described in (a) above.

14. Other sign ordinances. All signs allowed by these regulations shall comply with further sign regulations of the zoning code and the Code of Ordinances. In the event of a conflict of these regulations and the further sign regulations of the zoning code and the Code of Ordinances, these regulations will control.
15. Variance procedures. Administrative decisions applying the provisions of this section may be appealed to the board of zoning adjustment according to the procedure provided for in section 27-44-337 of the Code of Ordinances.




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





FRONT ELEVATION



Re: Resolution on Severance Tax Issue

Attached is draft Resolution requested by at least two members of the Board at the February 21 regular meeting regarding the proposed initiative on the Natural Gas Severance Tax Act of 2012.

The proposed initiated act increases the severance tax on natural gas extracted from within the State of Arkansas to a flat 7% of the market value of the gas at the time it is extracted from the ground, and includes various other measures that alter the existing severance tax structure. The current rate is 5% or less. It also includes measures directing the resulting increase in state revenues should be allocated, specifically to the state's Highway and Transportation Fund, County Aid Fund, and Municipal Aid Fund.

If the initiative is successful in placing the proposal on the ballot for the November, 2012 general election, and ultimately receives voter approval, cities would theoretically stand to receive greater funding from the state's Municipal Aid fund for city streets. However, it is the opinion of many in opposition to this measure across the state that the increased severance tax would place Arkansas at an economic disadvantage to neighboring states, and that there is real potential for the loss of jobs and industry in Arkansas due to a higher natural gas severance tax. It is felt that an increased severance tax would also result in the loss of further economic development in the state.

The request from the Board meeting was for a Resolution to be drafted stating the City of Fort Smith's opposition to the proposed initiative on the Natural Gas Severance Tax Act of 2012. The Resolution stands ready to be included on the agenda for the Board's regular meeting on March 6.

For your information, I have also attached a page that was included in the February, 2012 issue of the Arkansas Municipal League's *City & Town* magazine.

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE INITIATIVE KNOWN AS THE NATURAL GAS SEVERANCE TAX ACT OF 2012

WHEREAS, the natural gas industry has created, and continues to create, thousands of jobs that pay significantly higher salaries than the state average; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Arkoma Basin, Fayetteville Shale, and other natural gas producing regions of the state, has had a tremendous positive impact on the economy of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the natural gas severance tax rate in Arkansas was increased dramatically in 2008, and those tax collections are up 4,000%; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas' current effective natural gas severance tax rate is comparable to those of surrounding states; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the development of shale formations across the country creates a competitive environment for exploration resources; and

WHEREAS, the proposed initiative known as the Natural Gas Severance Tax Act of 2012 would take hundreds of millions of dollars out of the local economies of Arkansas' natural gas producing counties and communities; and

WHEREAS, the 7% flat severance tax proposed by this initiated Act would be among the highest in the country and would threaten Arkansas' ability to compete for natural gas drilling capital and the resulting jobs and positive economic impact.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas that the City of Fort Smith is opposed to the proposed initiative known as the Natural Gas Severance Tax Act of 2012 due to the Board's understanding that increasing the natural gas severance tax would be detrimental to the further development of natural gas resources in Arkansas and potentially cause loss of jobs and economic investment in Arkansas.

Natural gas severance tax rates for Arkansas and surrounding states



Arkansas

The Arkansas severance tax on natural gas ranges from 1.25 percent to 5 percent depending on the type of gas well and the current state of a particular well. For “high-cost gas,” which includes all gas taken from the Fayetteville Shale, the rate is 1.5 percent for the first three years of production. If the high-cost gas well has not achieved “payout” (recovery of all costs of drilling and operating the well during the cost recovery period of three years) then the 1.5 percent will be extended until payout is achieved or an additional 12 months, whichever occurs earlier. After achieving payout then the tax goes to 5 percent until the rate of production is equal to or less than 100 Mcf per day at which time the well is described as “marginal gas.” Marginal gas is taxed at the lowest rate of 1.25 percent. Under Arkansas law, severance tax is applied to the “market value” of the gas, which is defined as the actual cash receipts from the sale of natural gas to the first purchaser less the actual costs to the producer of dehydrating, treating, compressing and delivering the gas to the purchaser.

Oklahoma

The Oklahoma severance tax rate is 7 percent with no exceptions. However, Oklahoma does employ a sliding scale depending on the price of natural gas. The scale is thus: If the average price of gas equals or exceeds \$2.10 per Mcf the tax is 7 percent; if the average price of gas is less than \$2.10 but is equal to or exceeds \$1.75 per Mcf the tax is 4 percent; and if the price of gas is less than \$1.75 per Mcf the tax is 1 percent.

Texas

The Texas severance tax rate is 7.5 percent, but Texas has an exemption for “high-cost” (shale) wells. The Texas exemption provides for a reduction from the 7.5 percent for the first 120 consecutive calendar months of production or until the cumulative value of the tax reduction equals 50 percent of the drilling and completion costs (calculated on a sliding scale based on actual development costs versus a state-wide average of well development costs), whichever occurs first. An example: If well development costs are \$2.8 million, as currently maintained by Southwestern Energy, the Texas tax would be reduced to 3.5 percent until \$1.4 million had been recovered or 10 years, whichever occurs first, then the tax would go to 7.5 percent. Texas also has a tax provision for low-producing wells (60 Mcf per day), but it only offers a tax rate reduction for those wells when natural gas prices fall below \$3.50 and then applies a sliding scale similar to Oklahoma.

Louisiana

The Louisiana severance tax is set annually based on average market prices over the past 12-month period compared to the 12-month period ending March 31, 1990. This number (the percentage of which was 234.68 percent for April 1, 2010, to March 31, 2011) is called the “gas base rate adjustment” and is added to the base tax rate of seven cents per Mcf. This produces a current tax rate of 16.4 cents per Mcf through June 30, 2012, when it will be recalculated.
