

PROCLAMATION

OFFICE OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FORT SMITH, ARKANSAS TO THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF FORT SMITH AND THE BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF SEBASTIAN COUNTY

WHEREAS, a 15-day filing period was held May 16, 2018 thru Noon on May 31, 2018 for the offices of Mayor and Directors-at-Large Positions No. 5, 6, and 7; and,

WHEREAS, three (3) individuals, i.e. George B. McGill, Luis Andrade, and Russell Wayne Haver, filed and have been certified as candidates for the office of Mayor thus necessitating a municipal primary election in accordance with Arkansas State Annotated § 14-48-109 (7); and,

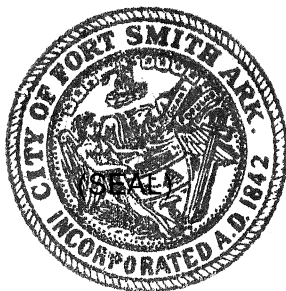
WHEREAS, three (3) individuals, i.e. Samuel Price, Robyn Dawson, and Libby Piatt, filed and have been certified as candidates for the office of Director-at-Large Position 5 thus necessitating a municipal primary election in accordance with Arkansas State Annotated § 14-48-109 (7); and,


WHEREAS, the municipal primary election shall be held on the second Tuesday of August preceding the municipal general election in accordance with Arkansas State Annotated § 14-48-109 (a)(2)(B)(i);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SANDY SANDERS, Mayor of the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby proclaim that a municipal primary election will be held for registered voters in the city of Fort Smith, Arkansas, on Tuesday, August 14, 2018 for the purpose of voting for candidates for the position of Mayor and Director-at-Large Position 5. In the event no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in the primary, the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the aforementioned offices will be voted upon in the municipal general election on November 6, 2018.

The Board of Election Commissioners of Sebastian County are hereby requested to cause notice of such election to be published in their county as required by law, and to hold and conduct such election in the same manner as is provided by law with respect to other city elections.


